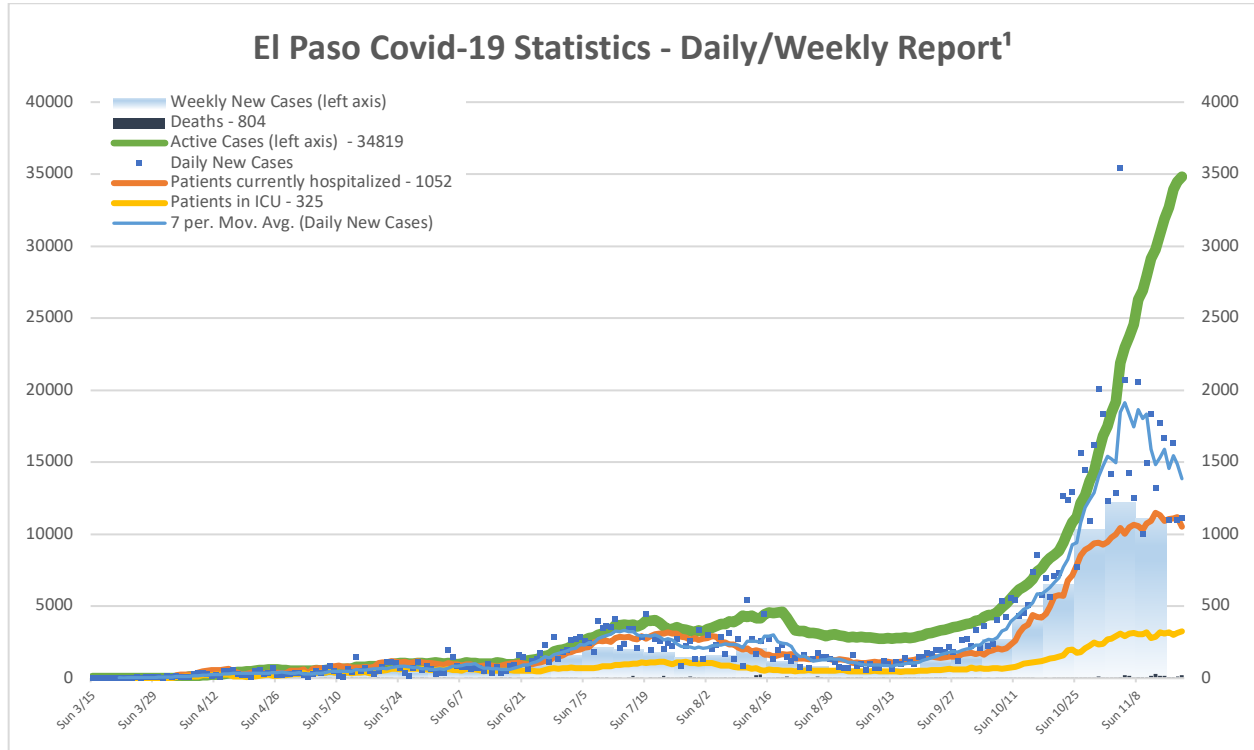


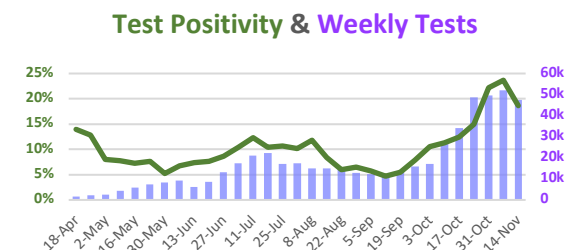


- Summary:**
- ▶ **900+ new cases (180+ delayed); 330+ new active cases (lowest in nearly 1 mo.)**
 - ▶ **Hospitalizations lower, ICU patients higher (setting new record)**
 - ▶ **22 deaths reported today in El Paso, 29 in Juárez; 1 in 25 currently infected**
 - ▶ **Weekly new cases ↓22% compared to this time last week**
